Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission to Bhagwant Ayurvedic Medical College and Bhagwant Hospital, Vill- Kelapur Jasmaur, Teh- Jansath, Bhagwantpuram, 17th milestone Bijnor- Delhi Highway, Muzaffarnagar- 251315, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0506) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

## Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- 1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely BhagwantAyurvedic Medical College and Bhagwant Hospital, Vill- KelapurJasmaur, Teh-Jansath, Bhagwantpuram, 17th milestone Bijnor-Delhi Highway, Muzaffarnagar-251315, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0506) inspection of your College was conducted on 09.05.2023 & 10.05.2023 on hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Asessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- 2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
- Further, three faculties of your institution were proven to be physically absent but working only on 3. paper teacher in the academic year 2022-23 and in accordance with section 28(1)(f) of NCISM Act 2020, regulation 3(1)(f) of RMS, 2016 as per the letter of MARBISM vide letter no 26-75/2021visitation dated 31/8/2021 and letter no. 3/2022/MARB/General Matter dated 17/8/22, a penalty of Rs. 75,00,000/- was imposed on your institution as three faculties namely Dr. Preeti Muthal(AYST01526), (AYRB01688), Dr. Bharati Motiram Dr. Pooja Subhash Dhayatadak(AYPS01188) were proven to be physically not present but working only on paper and the same was communicated to you vide letter no.Teacher Verification/MARB/2022 dated 17.03.2023.

- 4. Meanwhile, as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the 54<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 22.08.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria for issuance of Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 and Board decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to your college. Accordingly, the hearing was conducted on 01.09.2023 to present the case through virtual mode.
- 5. Further, in response of the **Penalty letter vide letter no.Teacher Verification/MARB/2022** dated **17.03.2023**, you have deposited 25% (Rs 18,75,000) of the total imposed penalty amount in favour of The National Commission fund for Indian System of Medicine through RTGS vide **UTR No. PUNBR52023083018471087 dated 30.08.2023** through Punjab National Bank, Kaithora and informed the same vide an email dated 30.08.2023 enclosing a letter vide ref. no. BGI/RA/060/4872 dated 01.09.2023. It is further informed that the remaining penalty amount should be paid in three equal installments before the commencement of permission process for the Academic year 2024-25. In case of failure of payment of the complete penalty amount within the stipulated time, the permission process for the academic year 2024-25 and subsequent years will be withheld.
- 6. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 57<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 05.09.2023. Board verified the same and found that the College is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria and the Board decided to verify and confirm the receipt of payment of penalty and then to grant Conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.
- 7. Therefore, after confirming the receipt of first installment of penalty, Conditional Permission is granted to Bhagwant Ayurvedic Medical College and Bhagwant Hospital, Vill-KelapurJasmaur, Teh-Jansath, Bhagwantpuram, 17<sup>th</sup> milestone Bijnor-Delhi Highway, Muzaffarnagar-251315, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0506) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements: -
  - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
  - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatary Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 9. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any

University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

- 10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 11. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25: -
  - all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
  - ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda).
  - iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
- 12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
